Cottonwood St. Drainage Improvement Project — Construction on the Cottonwood Street Drainage Improvement Project is scheduled to begin the week of November 4, 2024. The city has contracted SJ Anderson Co. to carry out the work, which is expected to be completed within 30 days of starting. The project will involve the installation of six new driveway culverts and grading work, which will include a new drainage swale on the north side of the road, stretching between 106 E. Cottonwood St. and 260 E. Cottonwood St. This improvement aims to enhance drainage in the area and address concerns raised by residents.

Fire Department & Chamber Event — The Cottonwood Fire Department partnered with the Greater Verde Valley Chamber of Commerce to host a Lunch & Learn event on Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at the Recreation Center. 


