**CrowdStrike Outage** – In the wake of the CrowdStrike outage events that brought down 8.5 million Windows machines worldwide last week, the City of Cottonwood's IT Department conducted thorough assessments to confirm that all servers and PCs are usable and online. Our priority remains to ensure the security and stability of our systems while minimizing any disruptions to our workflow. Thank you to CloudIT support staff, Joseph Meagher, Alejandra Ramirez, Steve Hensyel and Katelyn Dotson for their efforts in getting all systems up and running smoothly. With a special thank you to Joseph Meagher who worked overnight to make sure that the Communications Center was up and functioning properly after the outage.

**Fire Department's Back to School Supply Drive** - The Cottonwood Fire Department held the annual Back to School Supply Drive at the local Walmart today, July 26th, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The community has shown great generosity by donating various items, including pencils, notebooks, dry erase markers, folders, disinfecting wipes, and much more! 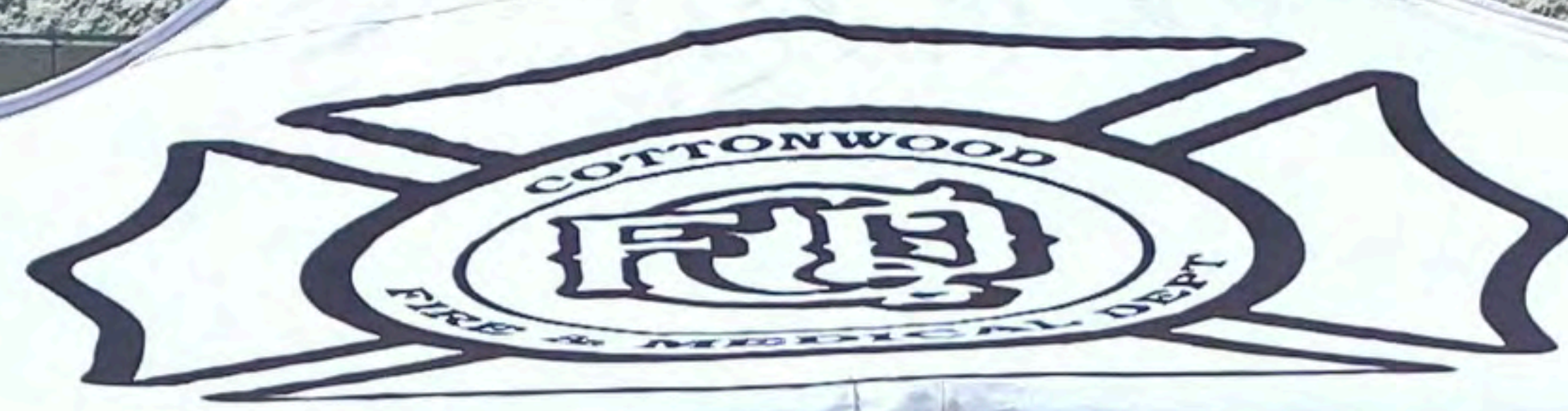

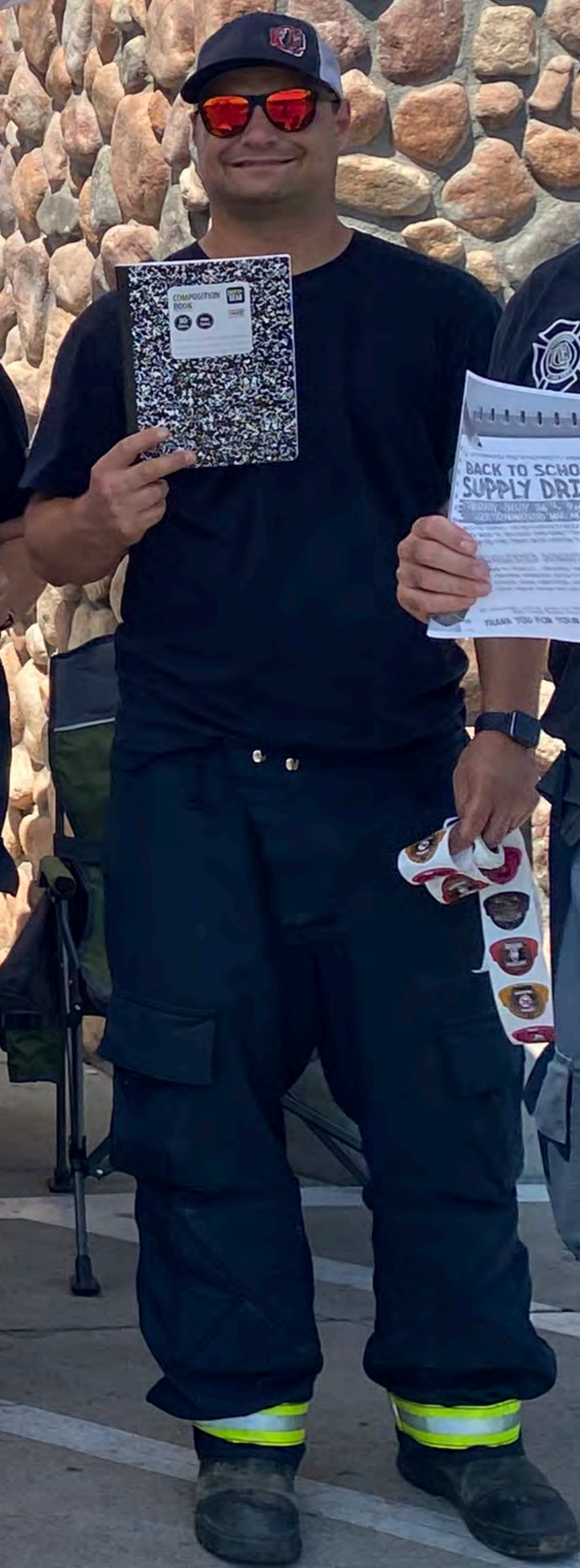
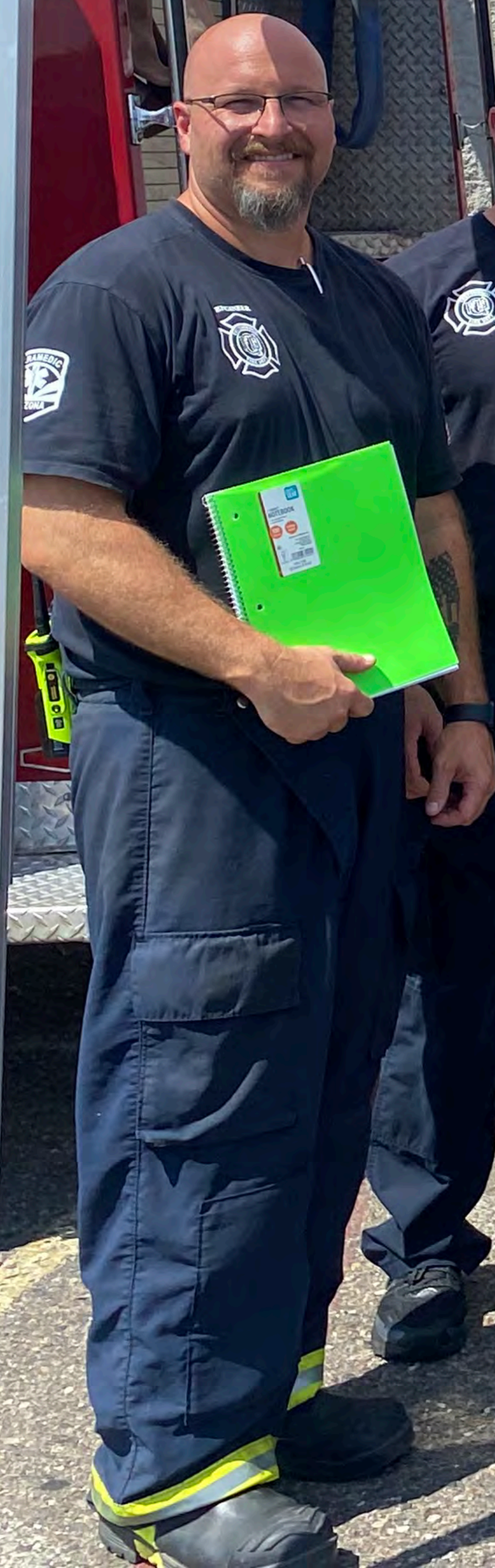
