Cottonwood Police Department – Cottonwood Police Commander Gareth Braxton-Johnson would like to thank all law enforcement officers for all the work and effort they do to keep the community safe and to provide the most effective, courteous, and professional police services to our community. The Cottonwood Police command staff are working to share these comments received from the community so they can be viewed in "real time", showing the difference each of our dedicated officers make.

According to Commander Gareth Braxton-Johnson, "the ratings among dispatch, police and other services that interact with our community in a public-facing manner, are well above "4" of out of "5" in terms of ratings. Juxtapose this with the fact that often when citizens call the police, it's not likely under the most ideal circumstances. In other words, they call in times of crisis or chaos and look to all of you to be that stabilizing voice of calm, and reassurance. Thank you for the time you make to serve our community, and to make each contact a meaningful and lasting impact on our citizens, as I like to call it, "An opportunity to build trust and transparency." Your efforts have not gone unnoticed." Please review the survey responses from community members attached.

Public Works – On Sunday, September 8, 2024, Arizona Lines will begin work on the FY 2025 fall striping application. During this application, all roadway pavement markings will be restriped. The work will be performed between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. This work is expected to be completed within two weeks.

Community Development – On September 3rd, the City Council approved Resolution 3315 to amend the stipulations to the February 20, 2024 approval of the "6 on Sixteen" Final Plat. The amendment of the stipulation grants more time for the applicant to have the Plat recorded.






