COTTONWOOD, AZ — We're excited to share that we have carefully reviewed the valuable feedback and recommendations from our community following the recent resurfacing of the indoor pool this spring. We're committed to making enhancements that will elevate your experience in the coming weeks and will be accomplishing some planned warranty work.

The planned warranty work includes:

- Lighting: Adding additional anchors for improved safety and stability.
- Drain Covers: Replacing current covers with flat grates to enhance user comfort and accessibility.
- Ladders: Modifying ladders to be flush with the wall for a smoother entry and exit in the lazy river.
- Tot Slide: Upgrading the landing mat to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for our younger swimmers.

Please note that the indoor pool will be closed beginning Saturday, October 19, and we anticipate reopening on Saturday, October 26.
