The building will be remodeled to have two retail spaces on the first floor and four hotel units on the second floor and be known as Tavern Lofts. On Monday, October 21, the Planning and Zoning Commission granted Design Review approval for the addition of a single-story food service unit to the existing commercial structure, known as Strada, located at 1054 N. Main Street. On Monday, October 21, the Planning and Zoning Commission approved the modification of the stipulations to allow additional time to develop a 44-unit apartment complex, known as San Cipriano Apartments, located at 1308 E. Cherry Street. On Monday, October 21, the Planning and Zoning Commission passed a vote to recommend approval to City Council regarding a Zoning Ordinance text amendment to Section 301: Amendments or Zone Changes regarding application procedures


